



DIRECTIONS TO ELK RIVER CAMP

From North or Kansas City Area

Hwy 71 south, exit right on EE Hwy to Lanagan, MO. Turn right on EE Hwy and go 3 miles, then left on Hwy 59 South. Follow Hwy 59 south 3 miles. Turn left on Elk Springs Road. Go one quarter of a mile on Elk Springs Road and then turn right into Elk River Campground before you cross the low water bridge.

From South or Arkansas area

I-540 then Hwy 71 north at stateline, go approx. 8 miles to H Hwy (right off 71 Hwy at Pineville, MO). Right on H Hwy approx. 4 miles to Elk Springs Road. Then turn right on Elk Springs Road. Follow Elk Springs Road 2 miles, go across low water bridge then turn left into Elk River Campground.

From Grove, OK area

Hwy 25 from Grove to stateline. Go 1 mile further to Hwy 43. Turn right on Hwy 43, go 5 miles to Hwy 90. Turn left on Hwy 90, go approx. 7 miles to Noel. At the junction of Hwy 59 & 90, take a left on Hwy 59. Follow Hwy 59 north 5 miles to Ginger Blue. Turn right off Hwy 59 onto Elk Springs Road. Go one quarter of a mile on Elk Springs Road then turn right into Elk River Campground (before you cross the low water bridge).

Springfield area

Follow I-44 to Joplin then take Hwy 71 south, exit right on EE Hwy to Lanagan, MO. Turn right on EE Hwy and go 3 miles, then left on Hwy 59 South. Follow Hwy 59 south 3 miles. Turn left on Elk Springs Road. Watch for billboard sign on left before turn. Go one quarter of a mile on Elk Springs Road and then turn right into Elk River Campground.

DIRECTIONS TO WAYSIDE

From North or Kansas City area

Hwy 71 south, exit right on EE Hwy to Lanagan, MO. Turn right on EE Hwy and go 3 miles, then left on Hwy 59 South. Follow Hwy 59 South 7 miles to Noel. Cross Elk River bridge and then turn right on Hwy 90 West. Go 100 yards and then turn right into Wayside Campground.

From Arkansas area

540 then Hwy 71 north to stateline, then go 4 miles further to Hwy 90. Turn left on Hwy 90, 14 miles to Noel to end of Main Street (Hwy 90 brings you right on to Main), turn right, go under bluff and beside river, straight thru next stop sign, 100 yards turn right into Wayside Campground.

From Grove, OK area

Hwy 25 from Grove to stateline. Go 1 mile further to Hwy 43. Turn right on Hwy 43, go 5 miles to Hwy 90. Turn left on Hwy 90, go approx. 7 miles to Noel. As you come into Noel turn left into Wayside Campground right before the intersection of 59 & 90.

Kansas area

Hwy 71 south to EE Hwy, right turn off Hwy 71, exit right on EE Hwy to Lanagan, MO. Follow EE Hwy 4 miles then left on Hwy 59 South. Follow Hwy 59 South 7 miles to Noel. Cross Elk River bridge and then turn right on Hwy 90 West. Go 100 yards and then turn right into Wayside Campground.

Springfield area

Follow I-44 to Joplin then take Hwy 71 south, exit right on EE Hwy to Lanagan, MO. Turn right on EE Hwy and go 3 miles, then left on Hwy 59 South. Follow Hwy 59 South 7 miles to Noel. Cross Elk River bridge and then turn right on Hwy 90 West. Go 100 yards and then turn right into Wayside Campground.

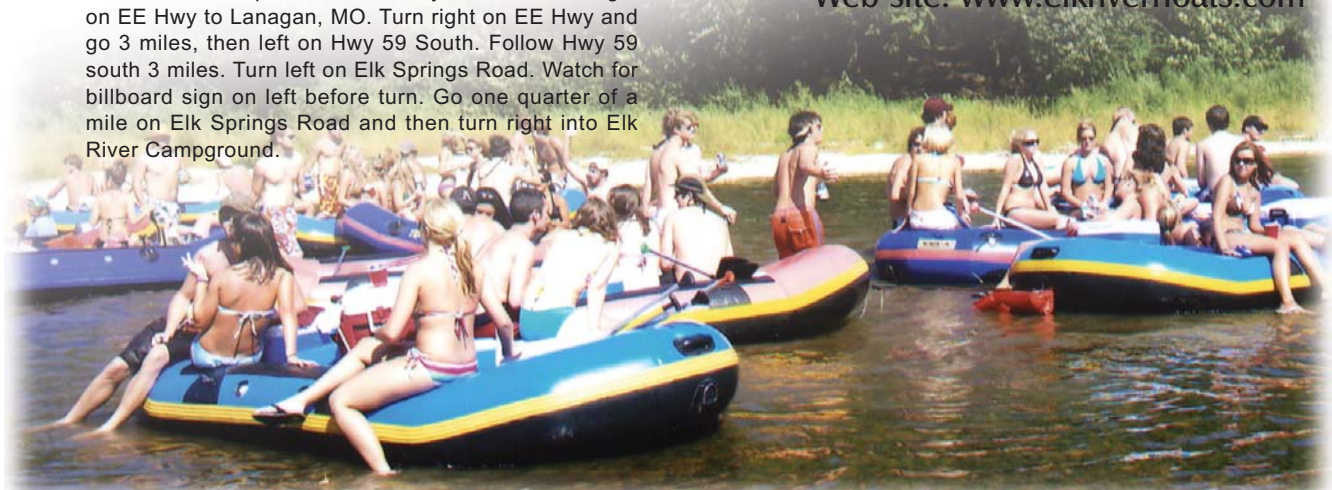

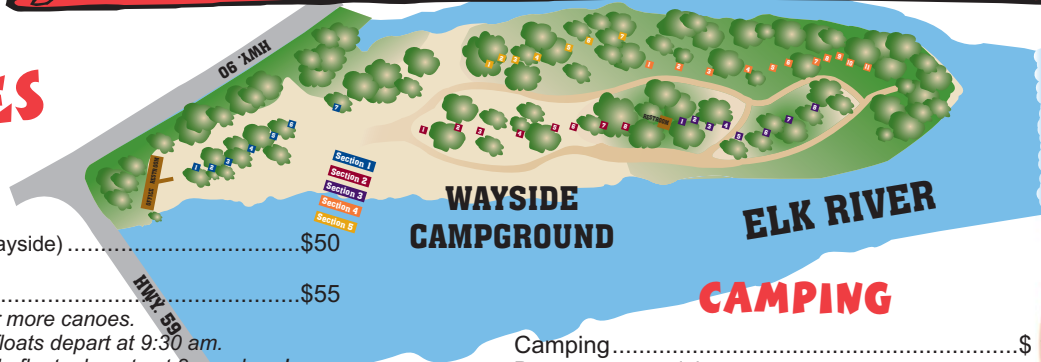

POLICIES

Floating reservations are highly recommended for everyone on weekends and for groups during the week. Float trips paid in advance will guarantee your floating equipment until 11:00 am on float date.

Departures:

Sunday - Friday starting 9:00 am until 2:00 pm.
Saturday starting 8:00 am until 3:00 pm.
Unless previous arrangements are made.

Money received for reserved floating equipment will be refunded, if partial or all reservations are cancelled 14 days prior to float date. Rescheduling is available if the river is at flood stage.

You, the renter, are responsible for your party members and all rented equipment. Use good judgement on the water. Don't over-estimate your abilities on the river. Please do not hesitate to ask our staff for canoeing tips and conditions and be prepared for rain or shine. A release must be signed for all rented equipment.

Ice, drinks, snacks, lotion, rain gear, sunglasses, etc. are available at the office store.

Camping, guaranteed with a floating reservation, on a first come first serve basis. We have many shady spots equipped with water and electric hookups. We also have large beach areas with shallow swimming for children. All visitors must register at the office or with the gate attendant. If you are a late night arrival, please set up quietly and pay in the morning. Quiet hours are from 10:30 pm to 8:00 am. Please limit noise at your campsite.

We want everyone to have a great time so please respect your camping neighbor and the beautiful surroundings. Please keep the park clean. No littering. Speed limit 5-10 mph. Stay clear of loose beach gravel & the river.

Dogs: Due to liability issues we no longer allow dogs at Elk River Floats or Wayside Campground.

No firearms or fireworks. Keep music within your camp. Respect the trees, don't chop, nail or saw. Hang lanterns so they don't burn trunks and branches – they're giving you shade.

No glass in campground or on river.
